MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Rumpf stated there was nothing to report at this time.

CLERK'S REPORT: Clerk/Treasurer Juanita Puente reported that she is working on new grants, facilitating quotes and sending in Notice of Obligations for quote approvals for contractors to begin projects at the Senior Center, Rodeo Grounds and Library.

EMS REPORT – A report was submitted by EMS Coordinator, James Nelson and reviewed by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees. He reported that there were seven (7) EMS calls in the month of July.

FIRE – A report was submitted by Assistant Fire Chief, Charlie Blaylock and reviewed by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees. He reported that the Magdalena Volunteer Fire Department met three (3) times in July for training on safety and different nozzles, they inspected trucks at Hop Canyon and the Magdalena Fire Station. **MARSHAL** – A report was submitted by Marshal Michael Zamora and reviewed by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees.

JUDGE – There was no report available.

PUBLIC WORKS – A report was submitted by Joint Utility Manager Robert Aguilar and was reviewed by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees.

LIBRARY – A report was submitted by Librarian Yvonne Magener and reviewed by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees.

Mayor Rumpf stated that there would be additional electrical work needed to hook everything up and that may put us over budget on the \$40,000.00 Grant.

AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND PROJECT APPROVAL TO THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, <u>VILLAGE OF MAGDALENA</u> (the "Governmental Unit") is a duly organized [name of type of entity] created and formed pursuant to [name of act, and citation to act, authorizing creation of, or creating, the Governmental Unit] and is a qualified entity under the New Mexico Finance Authority Act, Sections 6-21-1 through 6-21-31, NMSA 1978 ("Act"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act the Finance Authority has developed an application procedure whereby the Governing Body may submit an application ("Application") to the Finance Authority for planning grant financial assistance from the Fund; and

WHEREAS, the <u>VILLAGE OF MAGDALENA</u> of the Governmental Unit (the "Governing Body") desires to submit an Application for financial assistance from the Fund for a Planning Document, as defined in the Rules Governing the Local Government Planning Fund currently in effect and as specifically identified below, for the benefit of the Governmental Unit; and

"WHEREAS, the Governing Body intends to submit the Planning Document to evaluate and estimate the costs of implementing feasible alternatives for meeting water and wastewater public project needs of the drinking water system for the Village of Magdalena ("Project") for the benefit of the Governmental Unit and its citizens; and"

WHEREAS, the application prescribed by the Finance Authority to finance the Planning Document [in whole/in part] with financial assistance from the Fund has been completed, submitted to, and reviewed by the Governing Body, and this Resolution approving submission of the completed Application to the Finance Authority for its consideration and review is required as part of the Application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY:

- Section 1. That all lawful actions previously taken by the Governing Body and the Governmental Unit and their respective officers and employees in connection with the Application and the Project are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
- Section 2. That the completed Application submitted to the Governing Body is hereby approved and confirmed.
- Section 3. That the officers and employees of the Governmental Unit are hereby directed and requested to submit the completed Application to the Finance Authority and are further authorized to take such other action as may be requested by the Finance Authority in connection with the Application and to proceed with arrangements for financing the Project.
- Section 4. All acts and resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby rescinded, annulled and repealed.
 - Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.






